With the MALDI Biotyper being the gold standard for microbial identification in many laboratories worldwide, the threshold to increase the number of samples for identification has become minimal due to the low consumable cost per sample, ease of use and fast time-to-result.

Automated sample preparation for MALDI-TOF analysis becomes the next logic step to an improved microbiology workflow. Automated MALDI target plate preparation reduces not only manual labor, also the possibility of human errors in sample misplacement and/or possible cross-contamination are minimized. The MBT Pathfinder GP combines semi-automated colony picking based on adjustable geometry, mimicking the movement of a hand, with a unique sample preparation procedure of transferring the colonies onto the MALDI target plate.


- Semi-automated robotic solution combining the colony transfer functionality of the MBT Pathfinder GP with an automated Petri dish exchanger
- Carousel with a capacity for up to 100 Petri dishes

- Automated capping/uncapping of Petri dish covers
- Petri dishes are fed into the tray of the MBT Pathfinder GP by a high precision robotic arm
- Adding the Feeder GP Option frees up valuable technician work time









Cleverly designed process of colony picking and deposition




MALDI target and Petri dish are inserted for transfer of colonies




Pre-deposition of formic acid using a liquid deposition needle




Formic acid deposited only on positions preselected for colony transfer
